The CCC was founded in 2012 in order to promote cricket for the physically challenged in India, supporting and encouraging players and raising awareness. There are other organisations for the visually impaired, wheelchair players and for those who play with a soft ball, but CCC uses a standard



leather ball, enabling matches against regular teams—like CMC!

CCC draws its players from five zones (North, South, East West and Delhi/central) to make India A, B and C teams. They have organised tournaments at a national and international level, including a triangular series between India, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka, and Rotary Challengers Cup.
