



Symposium on Medical Education & Healthcare Services held

As part of the Centenary of Medical Education celebrations, a Symposium on Medical Education and HealthCare Services was held on October 8 and 9, 2018. The symposium addressed the larger challenges of training doctors across the country to meet the needs of healthcare in India. It brought together administrators and teachers of medical education from premier medical institutes including AIIMS, New Delhi; Maulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi; Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sewagram, Wardha, Maharashtra; CMC Ludhiana, Punjab and St. John's Medical College, Bangalore, Karnataka.

Faculty from Nodal Medical Education Units from different parts of the country, government and non-government stakeholders in public healthcare services, including the Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi; the Tamil Nadu State National Health Mission; the Directorate of Medical Education and the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University gathered to examine how medical education can be realigned to meet the healthcare objectives as envisaged in the National Health Policy 2017.
