CMC partners with N. Indian mission hospital to restore healthcare facilities in needy area

On 17th October 2017, a tripartite Memorandum of Agreement along with Terms of Reference was signed between Christian Medical College Vellore, Emmanuel Hospital Association (EHA) and Reynolds Memorial Hospital (RMH) Society, Washim, Maharashtra, at the EHA Head Office in New Delhi.

RMH, a 79-year-old hospital, which has been struggling to continue its services, had approached CMC for assistance. This is CMC's first partnership with a mission hospital in North India. This tripartite partnership has been formed with the vision to rebuild, restore and improve the health care facilities in the region.
