The annual students' medical missions' conference SHILOH 2021 was held virtually (online) from 30th September to 3rd October, 2021. The theme this year was 'Changing Times; Unchanging God'. The theme was based on Malachi 3:6 which is an expression of God's unchanging love and faithfulness during this uncertain time. It is also a reassurance that His standards and His holiness are unchanging.

This was the 14th year of SHILOH which is a movement that aims to develop leaders in the healing ministry of Christ in India and all over the world. It is meant to provide students, a perspective on medical missions by meeting leaders in the field and being challenged of their role in Christ's mission. This year there were nearly 2000 registrations for the event.

The plenary speakers were Dr. Vijay Kanth, Founder-Director of GIFT (Growth in Faith & Truth) and Rev. Isaac Johnson - Senior Pastor / Presbyter of St. Andrew's Church (The Kirk) in Chennai who shared the word of God in a simple yet powerful manner. The sessions were interspersed with moving presentations covering mission hospitals both from India and abroad. It was a great opportunity to listen to and be challenged by those who lived out their calling in the challenging circumstances. The group discussion gave an opportunity to closely interact with the participants and provided a time for reflection.



The John Scudder Oration for the year 2021 was delivered by Mrs. Bharathy Jacob, the former dean of the college of nursing, CMC, Vellore. She was recognised for her simplicity, humility, gentleness, an abiding faith in the Lord Jesus blended with courage, brilliance, and wisdom apart from her contribution to the field of nursing in the country.

Dr. Anna Pulimood, Principal gave the participants a window into CMC through her eyes as someone who had grown up in campus, studied and worked here subsequently. It was nice to be reminded of the many Godly people who lived sincere lives in this place and built up people.

This was followed by a moving and inspiring testimony of Mr. Reny George, a prisoner who changed his ways through his faith in God. This was a powerful reminder of how God can marvellously change even the worst person for the better.

SHILOH again proved to be an opportunity for members of the CMC community to voluntarily come and work together in conjunction with partner organisations for the glory of God.




