CME and Hands-on Workshop on Emergencies in ENT



The Department of ENT Unit-III, Christian Medical College, Vellore, conducted “ENT-ER 2024, a CME and Hands-on workshop on Emergencies in ENT” on 19th and 20th January, 2024. The field of Otolaryngology deals with various emergencies requiring timely initiation of treatment. The art of treating these patients involves thorough evaluation and quick decision making without compromise on the quality of management. Often the paucity of time to deliberate on the situation creates a stressful environment for the treating physician and the team members. As the saying goes the “eye sees only what the mind knows”. Proper exposure and knowledge of various emergency scenarios and following a standard protocol of management helps in better outcomes and patient management. This was the thought behind organising such a unique CME with practical demonstrations on emergencies in ENT.

The first day of the programme included interactive talks on topics dealing with various emergencies in otolaryngology by faculty from within each subspecialty of ENT and from the Departments of Head and Neck Surgery Unit-I and Dental surgery. This was followed by a panel discussion on intraoperative emergencies with practical case presentations and discussions.

There were over 200 registrations with delegates coming from various medical colleges in Tamilnadu, Kerala, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and Pondicherry. Rev. Paul Ravikumar commenced the programme with a word of prayer. Dr. Regi Kurien, Professor and Head of ENT Unit-III (Rhinology and Anterior Skull Base Unit), welcomed the gathering. Felicitations were offered by Dr Anila Chacko, Dr K.P.P Abhilash and Dr. Suma Susan Mathew, Professor and Head, ENT Department, highlighting the importance of having such focused instructional courses which will benefit the postgraduates.

Dr Sophia A, Associate Professor, Indira Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Pondicherry was invited as a guest faculty and offered her expertise and practical suggestions during the panel discussion and workshop. Dr Lalee Varghese, Professor, Department of ENT Unit-III proposed the vote of thanks. The CME concluded in the evening with a Quiz on ENT emergencies for the postgraduates and delegates held in Hotel Surabhi International, Vellore, which was followed by dinner.

Sponsorship for Staff Children – Admissions 2024 – 2025

Applications are invited from staff for sponsorship of their children for admission to the various training courses in the Christian Medical College, Vellore for the Academic Year 2024 - 2025. Online sponsorship forms will be available in the Intranet page à Staff Self Service à Sponsorship Portal from 13th February 2024 onwards. Retired Staff can kindly contact Directorate for applying online sponsorship form.

A. Eligibility: (Cl.Min.No.5188-11-79; 7449:6:93 & 9282:1-2003)

1. Only children of confirmed C.M.C staff members who:

(a) have put in 10 years of continuous service including period of probation and are currently in service in any capacity in the Institution as on 30th June of the year under consideration; (OR)

(b) have retired after at least 15 years of continuous service in the Institution, or have taken voluntary retirement after 25 years of continuous service; (OR)

(c) have been discharged from service on medical grounds after at least 15 years of continuous service; (OR)

(d) have died during service after at least 10 years of continuous service in this Institution are eligible to apply for sponsorship.

2. Legally adopted children of staff members whose adoption was finalized at least five years before the date of application are also eligible for sponsorship, subject to the above criteria.

3. Regarding a confirmed staff member who died during service to the institution and whose spouse has been given a job in CMC in place of the deceased staff member, dependent children of the deceased staff member will be eligible for CMC sponsorship if the cumulative years of service of the deceased staff member and his/her spouse (including probation and confirmed periods) exceeds 10 years; in case the child applying for sponsorship was legally adopted by the deceased staff member, the adoption of the child should have been finalised :

(a) prior to the death of the deceased staff member, and

(b) atleast five years before the date of application for sponsorship

B. Conditions for sponsorship of staff children (Cl. Min.5759:3-84)

(a) Only one child from a family can be admitted in a year to any single course.

(b) Children from the same family can, however, be admitted to different course in the same year.

(c) Sponsorship is allowed from only one sponsoring body, so children applying for C.M.C. sponsorship cannot also be sponsored by one of the supporting Churches of the Council.

(d) Where there is more than one sponsorship obtained, the one received first which satisfies the criteria will be accepted.

(e) No withdrawal of first received valid sponsorship is allowed.

Staff children, even with CMC sponsorship, must still meet the minimum academic qualifications for the courses for which they are applying. Staff are urged to check the prospectus to ensure the eligibility of their children for the various courses before submitting their applications.

Last date for submitting sponsorship application forms (hard copy) to the Director, Christian Medical College, Vellore on 22/03/2024 at 4.30 pm.

Last date for submission of copy of self-attested mark sheet of qualifying examination to be announced. Please watch the CMC Intranet Home page for details. (Please note as per Tamil Nadu Government Orders – for MBBS admission First and single attempt marks only will be considered).
