Mrs. Roselin V. Rhenius Retires



Mrs. Roselin V. Rhenius, Professor in the Department of Medical Surgical Nursing, retired on 18th March 2024 after serving the institution for 38 years with dedication. She completed her B.Sc. Nursing from the College of Nursing, CMC Vellore in 1985 and began her career as a staff nurse in the Community Health Nursing department. Later, she worked as a staff in the labour room. In 1990, she left the country to work as a Nurse midwife in the Ministry of Health, Bahrain and returned to the institution as a tutor in 1997. She completed her Masters in Nursing in Medical Surgical Nursing in 2003 and joined the Department of Radiation Oncology and Gastroenterology. She remained in the same department until her retirement. In 2012, she held the position of Nurse Manager in the specialty of Cardiology Nursing.

Mrs. Roselin was an outstanding unit manager and nurse who was highly efficient in her work. Her dedication to enhancing the quality of palliative patient care was truly commendable. She placed a particular emphasis on providing lifestyle education and spiritual counselling to patients who were undergoing radiation and chemotherapy. Mrs. Roselin was also an accomplished teacher and mentor to her students. She played a key role in the development of the curriculum for the Post Basic Diploma in Oncology Nursing and Palliative Care Nursing courses. Her contributions to professional organisations in various capacities have been widely appreciated.

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She was the recipient of the UICC award in 2006 and went on to be an observer of preventive oncology in MKSCC, USA for one month. She also served as a faculty in the Eastern University of Sri Lanka for one year. Mrs. Rosaline is a sincere and committed person whose faith in God encouraged many staff and students to navigate difficult paths in their professional and personal lives.

Her husband Mr. S. Vasanthkumar Rhenius is working as a supervisor in OPD and their daughter is doing her BOT at Chennai. The CMC family is thankful to Mrs. Roselin V. Rhenius for her dedicated service to the institution and wishes her a happy and blessed retirement life.

Thalassemia Awareness Programme and Camp Organised in Surat

The Department of Clinical Haematology organised a thalassemia awareness programme and camp in Surat on 2nd March, 2024. The theme for the event was, 'Thalassemia Support Group'.

The programme was organised by Ms. Gomathi Joseph, Sr. Social Worker, Department of Haematology, CMC Vellore in collaboration with Mr. Vajubhai Suhagiya, Mavtar Charitable Trust- Managing Trustee. The camp was organised through LOK Samarpan Trust- Smt. Anitaben Dilipbhai Thakkar Thalassemia Blood Transfusion Center, Surat with the help of the Director, Dr. Sanmukh Joshi.

The representatives from Lok Samarpan Trust, Surat opened the programme with a welcome address followed by an educative session by Dr. Uday Kulkarni, Professor of Haematology on the following topics:

- What is thalassemia?
- Types of thalassemia
- Transfusion of packed red cells - regular & monthly
- Chelation therapy
- Stem cell transplantation
- Coal India Scheme – Corporate social responsibility (CSR)
- Initiative and Prenatal diagnosis.

Dr. Uday Kulkarni introduced the team from CMC Vellore which will work towards organising financial support for the patients who require transplants. The team led by Ms. Gomathi Joseph, assured them that the cost of treatment including food and accommodation would be subsidised thus giving them hope to come forward for treatment.



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Thalassemia Awareness Programme and Camp Organised in Surat

Ms. Mahalakshmi P and Mr. Amose Vicky, HLA coordinators, along with Ms. Arifa, Clinical Assistant and Ms. Gomathi Joseph conducted swab tests for HLA for thalassemia-affected children and their siblings. Two sickle cell anaemia cases were also tested along with their siblings from (Friends Missionary Prayer Band) FMPB Surat. The HLA team, along with two nurses and a technician from Blood Bank, Surat, completed testing for 68 families with 168 swabs.

A CME was organised by Dr. Sanmukh Joshi, Director of the Blood Donation Centre, in which there were 23 participants (transfusion medicine physicians, haemato-oncologists, anaesthetists, paediatricians, physicians, gynaecologists, and cardiologists). He spoke on the outline of thalassemia, basics of transplantation, data on Haematopoietic Stem Cell Transplantation (HSCT) in Thalassemia aplastic anaemia, leukaemias, myeloma work done during the COVID pandemic and Novel cell and gene therapies at CMC Vellore. All patients and siblings received a gift as a token of appreciation for their active participation and they were grateful for this opportunity.



World Purple Day - 2024

The 'PURPLE DAY' - traces its origins back to 2008 when Cassidy Megan, a young Canadian girl, initiated the idea to increase awareness about epilepsy. Inspired by her struggles with the condition and the lack of understanding amongst her peers, Cassidy envisioned a day when people would wear purple to show support for individuals living with epilepsy. Her efforts led to the creation of Purple Day, officially recognised as March 26th, and it has since grown into a global movement embraced by individuals, organisations and communities worldwide. Events from the Department of Nephrology

The Department of Nephrology celebrated World Kidney Day with a series of events from 7th to 14th March, 2024. On 7th January 2024, screening programmes were conducted for early detection of Kidney diseases in Jawadi Hills and Rama Nayakan Palayam (RNP) in collaboration with the Departments of Community Health and Development (CHAD) and College of Nursing Community Health (CONCH). A total of 267 patients in RNP and 176 patients in Jawadi Hills were screened. Those patients who had abnormal urine and blood test reports are being followed up for further evaluation and management.



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World Kidney Day Celebrations

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In keeping with the 'Patient First' campaign which was organised by the institution, a patient get-together was organised on 13th March 2024. The patients had the opportunity to participate in programmes such as debate, skit, song and dance. The display of the 'Kidney Friendly Diet' organised by the staff of the dialysis unit was the highlight to the patients and public.

As part of the celebrations; poster, slogan and story-writing competitions were organised in which 220 staff and 17 patients participated.

The department is thankful to the CHAD and CON teams for their teamwork in extending our services beyond the tertiary care setting and reaching out to the community.



Events from the Paediatric Nephrology subdivision

On 14th March 2024 the Paediatric Nephrology subdivision celebrated the World Kidney Day. The Chief Guest for the inauguration was Dr. K.P.P. Abhilash, Associate Medical Superintendent. The event opened with prayer led by Rev. Paul Ravikumar, Chaplain followed by felicitations by Dr. Jolly Chandran, Deputy Director, Dr. Kala Ebenezer, Professor & Head, Paediatric department, Mrs. Mary Anbarasi, Head, Paediatric Nursing, Mrs. Shanthi Gladston, Deputy Nursing Superintendent and Dr. Deepthi. R.V., Associate Professor of Paediatric Nephrology.

There were stalls with dialysis therapists, nephrology nurses, and dietary experts, who demonstrated peritoneal and hemodialysis, and the ideal diet for children with kidney disease. Parents of children with chronic kidney disease were also educated on ways to enhance their child's appetite and meet their nutritional needs.

A special organ donation drive was organised during which many healthy volunteers registered to donate their organs after death. World Kidney Day-themed T-shirts were on sale and were very popular among both patients and staff. The World Kidney Day celebrations ended on a very optimistic note.

The paediatric nephrology speciality has been conducting World Kidney Day celebrations for the past 16 years. This activity has helped to increase awareness about kidney disease in the local community, both amongst children and their parents. Realising the importance of early screening, eating a healthy diet, regular exercise and focusing on personal health is a small beginning towards improving kidney health.

Applications are invited from candidates interested in applying for Institutional Recommendation* for broad specialty medical postgraduate courses. The application for institutional recommendation will be via an online form. The link for this application and the list of departments offering sponsorship will be made available, on the intranet page or by request from Principal's office (PG section) (princi.pg@cmcvellore.ac.in). The last date for application for institutional recommendation is **30th April, 2024**.

Please note the following :

- Candidates interested in being recommended for courses must contact the respective heads of department to discuss the same.
- Candidates who ask for recommendation from a department other than the broad specialty department, must also meet with the head of the broad specialty department.
- A candidate may apply for recommendation for sponsorship for a maximum of 3 courses.
- Candidates who fulfil the following criteria may apply:
 - CMC graduates who have fulfilled their service obligation. Non-minority candidates will be eligible to apply under the Institutional Preference Category.
 - Christian candidates from other institutions who have completed 2 years of work in a recognized mission hospital of which at least 6 months should have been in CMC. Christian candidates from other institutions applying for recommendation from a super specialty department and

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who have completed 2 years of work in a recognized mission hospital or in CMC, should have spent at least 6 months in the concerned super specialty department.
