State-Level Dissemination Workshop Conducted by RUHSA Department



The Rural Unit for Health and Social Affairs, CMC Vellore organised a state-level dissemination workshop with a photo-exhibition on 17th August 2024 in Chennai; on the theme: *Photovoice Study on Chronic Respiratory Disease (CRD) Patients and a Stride Towards Policy*.

Two community-level dissemination programmes were organised at Kilalathur on 1st August and in Latheri on 8th August. Photo exhibitions titled; *Life Experiences of People Living with Chronic Respiratory Disease* were a part of these events, which were covered by the local media outlet *The New Indian Express*. These exhibitions and workshops aimed to raise awareness about chronic respiratory diseases (CRD) and to inform policy through a multi-country collaborative research initiative titled; *Understanding the Views and Experiences of People Living with Chronic Respiratory Disease (CRD): An Adapted Photovoice Study*.

Objectives of the exhibitions and workshops:

- Raising Awareness Among Policymakers: To make regional and state-level policymakers aware of the impact of CRD on patients
- Facilitating Collective Action
- Advocating Policy Changes Through Photovoice: Using "photovoice" as a powerful advocacy tool to influence community and state-level policymakers in advocating for policy changes and setting clinical protocols to improve CRD care in Tamil Nadu.

The dissemination workshop was inaugurated by Dr. Solomon Sathishkumar, Principal, CMC Vellore. Dr. Jerard Selvam, Additional Director of National Health Mission, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Government of Tamil Nadu; Dr. A. Somasundaram, Additional Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, Government of Tamil Nadu; Dr. Nancy Glori, Professor of Respiratory Medicine from MMC Chennai; Dr. Chitrasena, Director of Health Services of Thirupathur; Dr. Rita Isaac, Director of Population Research in Karkinos Health Care and former Senior Professor at CMC Vellore; and Dr. Richa Gupta, Professor & Head of Respiratory Medicine, CMC Vellore, attended the state level dissemination workshop along with doctors and health personnel from RUHSA Department.

The background and results of the photovoice study were presented by Dr. Biswajit Paul, the Principal Investigator, followed by a detailed presentation on the study's methodology by Dr. Sangeetha, the Co-Investigator. As part of the session, video stories showcasing the experiences of two patients with chronic respiratory diseases (CRD) were shared, featuring personal narrations from the patients themselves. This was followed by an engaging discussion between policymakers, administrators, and the RUHSA team, focusing on CRD policy in Tamil Nadu and the use of photovoice as a compelling advocacy tool for raising awareness and influencing policy decisions.

A consensus was reached to develop a guidance document and recommendations for a CRD policy in Tamil Nadu. This document aims to provide a strategic direction towards forming policies that enhance the quality of care and support for individuals suffering from chronic respiratory diseases.



Community Level Workshops:

Kilalathur Village - 1st August 2024:

The dissemination was inaugurated by the Block Medical Officer, followed by an address from the Principal Investigator on the photovoice study. Dr. Shankar Ganesh, The Block Medical Officer of K.V.Kuppam, and Mr. Suresh, the President of Kilalathur Panchayat attended the workshop and gave their feedback. School students and members of the local community also participated in the workshop. They were shown video stories, accompanied by patient narration, that depicted the experiences of living with chronic respiratory illnesses..

Latheri Village - 08th August 2024:

The dissemination was inaugurated by Mr. Ravichandiran, the Block Chairman of K.V. Kuppam Block, followed by an address from the Principal Investigator on the photovoice study. Mrs. Jaya Murugesan, The councillor of Latheri; Mr. Mohan, The President of Latheri; Mr. Selva Kumar, The Vice President of Latheri; and Mr. Vishwanathan, The Govt. Clerk of Latheri, along with Mr. Murali, the School Correspondent of Sri Ramakrishna Primary & Nursery School in Latheri attended the workshop. School students and community members also took part in the workshop. They were shown video stories with the patient narration about living with chronic respiratory illnesses. The block chairman and the president of Latheri gave their feedback about the workshop at the end of the programme.



Bacterial Zoonoses Symposium and PGDMM Golden Jubilee Celebration

Bacterial Zoonoses: Indian Perspective

To commemorate the World Zoonoses Day, The Department of Clinical Microbiology conducted a symposium titled; *Bacterial Zoonoses: Indian Perspective* on July 6th, 2024 at the CK Job Hall, Paul Brand Building, CMC Vellore. The keynote address was by Dr. Siraj Khan, Scientist G, ICMR-RMRC, Dibrugarh, Assam on *Bacterial Zoonoses in the North East*. Dr. Solomon Sathishkumar, Principal; Dr. Jacob John, Additional Vice-Principal Research; graced the inaugural function. The CMC Vellore faculty delivered highly informative lectures by sharing their experience in *Food Borne Zoonoses* (Dr. V. Balaji), *Campylobacter* (Dr. Dhanalakshmi), *Animal bites* (Dr. KPP Abhilash), *Zoonotic TB* (Dr. Joy S Michael), *WGS for Zoonoses* (Dr. Jobin Jacob) and *Prevention of Zoonoses* (Dr. Karthik Gunasekaran). External faculty included Dr. Manisha Biswal (PGIMER, Chandigarh), Dr. Mudassar Chanda (ICAR-NIVEDI, Bangalore), and Dr. Gaurav Batra (THSTI, Faridabad) who talked on *Rickettsioses at Chandigarh*, *Modelling of Bacterial Zoonoses and PoCT for Zoonoses*.

9th Short Course on Hospital Infection Prevention and Control for Nurses



The Office of the Nursing Superintendent, in collaboration with the Hospital Infection Control Committee, successfully conducted their 9th Short Course on Hospital Infection Prevention & Control for Nurses from 9th -14th September 2024. The course was designed as an update on knowledge and skills on Hospital Infection Control, through lectures, practical sessions, group discussions, skill demonstrations, field visits and Microbiology laboratory visits by medical and nursing faculty. A total of 52 delegates registered, representing 33 different hospitals from 8 states across India. The inaugural programme began with a devotion led by Chaplain Ms. Saramma Kuruvilla and a song by the infection control nurses. Felicitations were offered by Dr. I Rajesh, Medical Superintendent and Chairman HICC, Dr John Antony Jude Prakash, Head of microbiology and secretary HICC. Ms. Alice Sony, nursing superintendent, gave the overview of the workshop followed by a vote of thanks by Dr. Hema Paul, Senior HIC officer.

The sessions included various aspects of infection prevention and control including surveillance, audits, accreditation and quality. The sessions were facilitated by a host of medical and nursing faculties. This year we had an external faculty Ms.Najla Al-Zadjali, head of Infection Control in healthcare, Central Department of Infection Prevention and Control, Sultanate of Oman, who shared the quality improvement initiative for hand hygiene, done in hospitals across Oman. Participants were encouraged to form Infection Control Committees in their facilities.

There were visits to CSSD, laundry, Bio-Medical waste disposal sites, and ICUs followed by a demonstration of methods for environmental surveillance, and detection of antibiotic resistance in the Microbiology laboratory. Participants went through skill stations, to demonstrate competencies in hand hygiene, BMW segregation and donning & doffing of PPE. Skills such as handling and dressing of central lines, and urinary catheterization were demonstrated. Participants learnt the technique of drawing blood samples using a Leur adapter & needle. Central line dressing was ably demonstrated by the line nurses' team. Participants proceeded to set goals for the implementation of standards in their respective hospitals. Participants expressed that they were more confident and equipped to maintain the IPC standards as per the statutory requirements in their facilities.

The course concluded on 14th September 2024 with a valedictory programme. Ms. Anne Jarone , Associate Nursing superintendent gave her felicitation, congratulated the participants on the completion of the course, and gave away the certificates. Mrs. Sophia Vijayanathan, Addl. Joint Secretary HICC gave a report of the short course, followed by vote of thanks by Mr. K.Senthamil Selvan. Ms. Jisha Susan Sabu, Chaplain, concluded the programme with a closing prayer.
