Fenn, a pioneering surgeon and former Head of the Surgery Department at CMC Vellore, this annual event aims to enhance the knowledge and skills of postgraduate students in General Surgery.




Lamp Lighting 2024: College of Nursing

Chief Guest Mrs. Mercy John, former Principal of the College of Nursing, Christian College, Bissamcuttack, Odisha, delivered a powerful address emphasising the essential values of compassion, integrity, and humility, which she described as the hallmark qualities of a professional nurse. CMC Vellore's Radiation Oncology Department honored at CAHOTECH 2024, for its Digital Initiatives



The Radiation Oncology Department at Christian Medical College (CMC) Vellore received two prestigious accolades at the CAHOTECH 2024 conference, held at the Indian Institute of Science (IISc) Bengaluru on 26th October 2024.

The “Paperless Transition in Radiation Oncology” project was awarded the Technology and Digital Transformation of the year award. This project initiated in 2019 by Dr. Simon Pavamani, aimed to replace the parallel paper chart system in Radiation Oncology. By transitioning to a single CMC hospital ID, the project streamlined data capture across campuses, consolidating patients’ medical history, treatment schedules, and radiation timelines into a unified electronic record. Dr. Balu Krishna, Dr. Benny Rajendra, and Dr. Hannah Thomas led the implementation, with the transition completed under Dr. Thomas Samuel Ram’s leadership in 2024.

The Quantitative Imaging Research and AI Lab (<https://qirail.cmcvellore.edu.in/>) led by Dr Simon Pavamani showcased their “Data Management Pipeline for AI Research in Radiation Oncology” which was awarded the “AI Research and Development Award- 2024”. This Data management pipeline automatically allows data flow from clinical environments to a research data lake. With ETL (extract, transform, load) processes for imaging and clinical data, this pipeline enables flexible, scalable and anonymized data organization for AI-driven analysis. This project, led by QiRAIL’s scientist Dr. Hannah Mary Thomas T. and Clinical Lead Dr. Balu Krishna S, supports multiple AI research initiatives in Radiation Oncology. These awards highlight CMC Vellore’s commitment to innovation and excellence in healthcare, reinforcing its position as a leader in the field of Radiation Oncology.

Inauguration of the BLS Nodal Centre



The Department of Continuing Nursing Education & Research (CNE&R) at the College of Nursing achieved a significant milestone by being accredited as a Nodal Centre for Basic Life Support (BLS) Training for nurses by the Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council (TNNMC). The newly established BLS training facility was officially inaugurated on October 19th, 2024, marking a key development in enhancing the professional training and certification of nurses in the region.

The inaugural programme began with a prayer and dedication by Ms. Saramma Kuruvilla, Senior Chaplain followed by a warm welcome address from Ms. Ida Sweetlin, Associate Professor at the College of Nursing. Dr. Henry Prakash, Associate Medical Superintendent, and Dr. Vinitha Ravindran, Dean of the College of Nursing, delivered felicitations to honor the occasion. Dr. Henry Prakash formally inaugurated the BLS training facility, and Ms. Arul concluded the event with the vote of thanks.

A total of 28 delegates from both within and outside the institution participated in the inaugural BLS training programme. This workshop marks a crucial development for CNE activities within the College of Nursing, especially since BLS certification is now mandatory for re-licensure of all nurses in Tamil Nadu. In addition to acquiring CNE credit hours, the training is integral for nurses seeking renewal of their licensure in the state. This initiative will benefit not only the 4000 nurses employed at the institution but also countless nurses across the state, particularly in and around the Vellore region.

The objectives of the workshop were to equip participants with the necessary skills to assess and provide BLS care for both adult and paediatric patients, focusing on restoring airway, breathing, and circulation. Faculty from the College of Nursing, all of whom are AHA-certified BLS trainers, facilitated the sessions, which emphasized hands-on practical training. The programme received positive feedback, with delegates expressing high satisfaction with the comprehensive nature of the workshop. In recognition of their participation, the Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council awarded 10 credit points to the nurses attending the workshop, further enhancing their professional qualifications.
