Report on the Heat-Related Illness Awareness Programme Organised by the Hospital Infection Control Committee & Heat-Related Illness Task Force



The Heat-Related Illness Awareness Programme was a three-day event, held on 24th to 26th April 2025. It was organised by Hospital infection control committee (HICC) in collaboration with the Heat Related Illness(HRI) taskforce, Town Campus, CMC, Vellore, to create awareness on the issue related to heat and its profound impact on human health and the environment. Heat-related illness is of concern, across India, including Tamil Nadu- being a southern state with a tropical climate, experiencing soaring temperatures exceeding 40°C, especially during the peak of summer, makes the region highly vulnerable to heat-related illnesses. In urban areas like Vellore, the problem is intensified by the Urban Heat Island effect, which further deteriorates living conditions and amplifies environmental stress.

Heat exposure presents a significant risk to public health, disproportionately affecting vulnerable groups such as children, senior citizens, pregnant women, outdoor workers, as well as patients, visitors and healthcare workers in healthcare settings. Healthcare facilities can play a key role in sharing health advisory and provide support to people for disseminating protective health interventions and providing valuable resources.

As part of this awareness campaign, various stalls were set up to highlight the importance of recognising the signs and symptoms of heat-related illnesses and taking proactive measures for prevention. These stalls displayed pictures and posters with explanation in English and other vernacular languages, to ensure that the common people can easily access the information. Infection Prevention and Control Nurses, also organised puppet shows to demonstrate real-time management of HRI and providing practical tips for prevention and management.

The inaugural function began with a prayer song by the infection control family followed by prayer and benediction by Mrs. Abisha Stalin, from Chaplaincy, setting a reverent tone for the event. Mrs. Arockiaseeli Mabel A, Deputy Nursing Superintendent, welcomed the dignitaries as well as the gathering. Felicitations were offered by Dr. Vikram Mathews, Director, who emphasized that heat stress is entirely preventable and lauded the efforts of the HRI Task Force for organising the awareness programme. He highlighted the urgent need for timely implementation of these measures to prevent fatalities from heat-related illnesses. Dr. I. Rajesh, Medical Superintendent, highlighted the factors that led to the inception of the HRI task force in May 2024, emphasized the trio of mitigation strategies: monitoring, prevention, and treatment. He emphasized the importance of raising awareness among staff, patients, and the community. Mr. Anand John Samuel, Associate General Superintendent provided an overview of the heat mitigation strategies, such as providing drinking water in all wards and OPDs, and implementing cooling measures like pedestal fans and air coolers within the institution. He also praised the efforts of the HRI task force summarised the activities of the HRI task force and underscored the importance of this awareness program in enhancing public health.

The ceremony concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Hema Paul, Physician and Senior Infection Preventionsist.

This theme highlights the intersection of neurodiversity and global sustainability, emphasising how inclusive policies and practices can drive positive change for autistic individuals and contribute to achieving the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

In commemoration of Autism Awareness Month in April 2025, the Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Unit (Nambikkai Nilayam), Department of Psychiatry, organised a series of awareness and social inclusion programmes aimed at promoting neurodiversity among society and healthcare professionals. A key highlight was the social equity event *"Celebrating Children with Autism"* held on 4th April, 2025, at College Campus. The event was honored by the presence of the Principal, Dr. Solomon Satishkumar (Guest of Honor), Dr. Manoranjitham (Head of Psychiatric Nursing), Rev. Joseph (Chaplain), Dr. Rajesh G. Approximately 60 children from Nambikkai Nilayam and Rehab along with their families participated in the programme. Each child was paired with a student volunteer who interacted and guided them through a range of fun activities and games. This thoughtful arrangement allowed parents a much-needed respite and the opportunity to take part in games and activities designed especially for them. A heartfelt testimony from a doctor couple from CMC shared their experiences of raising a neurodivergent child, offering encouragement and reminding everyone present of the strength that can be found through faith in Christ. Their story highlighted how faith can help overcome various challenges along the journey.

Continuing the spirit of awareness, a vibrant Autism Awareness 5K Run was conducted on 26th April, 2025, for students and hospital staff to foster inclusivity and understanding. Institutional Recommendation for Postgraduate Admissions 2025

Applications are invited from candidates interested in applying for Institutional Recommendation* for broad specialty medical postgraduate courses. The application for institutional recommendation will be via an online form. The link for this application and the list of departments offering sponsorship will be made available, on the intranet page or by request from Principal's office (PG section) (**princi.pg@cmcvellore.ac.in**). The last date for application for institutional recommendation is **16th May 2025.**

Please note the following:

- Candidates interested in being recommended for courses must contact the respective heads of department to discuss the same.
- Candidates who ask for recommendation from a department other than the broad specialty department, must also meet with the head of the broad specialty department.
- A candidate may apply for recommendation for sponsorship for a maximum of 3 courses.
- Candidates who fulfil the following criteria may apply
 - CMC graduates who have fulfilled their service obligation. Non-minority candidates will be eligible to apply under the Institutional Preference Category.
 - Christian candidates from other institutions who have completed 2 years of work in a recognized mission hospital of which at least 6 months should have been in CMC. Christian candidates from other institutions applying for recommendation from a super specialty department and who have completed 2 years of work in a recognized mission hospital or in CMC, should have spent at least 6 months in the concerned super specialty department.
 - Christian candidates from other institutions who have worked for a minimum of 6 months (out of the 2 years) in one of the hospitals managed by the CMC Missions Department (e.g. RMH, Washim, KMF, Kotagairi) can be recommended by the Missions Department; i.e. Institutional sponsorship for Missions, even if they have not worked in CMC
 - Last date for completion of 2 years' service: **31st October 2025** (proof of completion of service must be provided with the application).
- The CMC application form for PG courses must be filled separately from the application for institutional recommendation/ sponsorship (https://admissions.cmcvellore.ac.in/).
- Once the online sponsorship application form is filled and supporting documents uploaded, candidates will receive a copy of the submitted form via email. A printout of this form must be submitted to the concerned recommending departments.
- <u>Please note that candidates being recommended for a broad specialty course by a different</u> <u>Department, will need to submit a copy of the application to both the sponsoring Department and</u> <u>the concerned parent Broad Specialty Department for approval of the sponsorship.</u>

- *Institutional Recommendation does not guarantee selection into a course, nor does it guarantee a teaching cadre. If selected, on completion of the course, sponsored candidates will be appointed to serve in any area considered appropriate by the Christian Medical College, Vellore. This could be either in the sponsoring department, other related departments or in mission hospitals of supporting bodies and Churches of the Christian Medical College Vellore Council for a duration of three years.
