Report on National Paediatric Surgical Nursing Conference



The College of Nursing at Christian Medical College Vellore successfully hosted the National Paediatric Surgical Nursing Conference on June 12th, 2025. The event was held in honour of Dr. Vinitha Ravindran, Dean, College of Nursing, for her 35 years of dedicated service to the institution. With the theme *Transforming Paediatric Surgical Care: The Power of Nursing Excellence,* the conference featured keynote speaker Dr. Ani Grace Kalaimathi, Registrar, Tamil Nadu Midwives and Council, Chennai who encouraged nurses to strive for excellence in patient care and to make nurses' voices heard and their contributions recognised at both national and global levels.

Renowned experts from the country and across the globe, namely, Dr. John Mathai, Mrs. Shandrila Immanuel, Dr. Reju Joseph Thomas, Comrade Olubunmi Lawal-Aiyedun, Mrs. Shanthi Gladston, Dr. Ebor Jacob Gnananayagam J, Dr. Susan Jehangir Homi, Ms. Esther Kanthi, Dr. Naomi Wright, Mrs. Menaka Raghuraman and Dr. Sundeep M C Kisku discussed the latest advancements and challenges in paediatric surgical nursing across four plenary sessions.

Topics included innovations in perioperative care, paediatric surgical emergencies, patient advocacy, patient safety, and transformative practices. Over 450 nurses from across the country participated, engaging in discussions and presentations to enhance paediatric surgical care. Concurrent oral and poster presentations enabled nurses to share their research and experiences, with prizes awarded to the best presentations.

The conference concluded with a valedictory ceremony, and the chief guest for the function was Dr. Sundari Edwin, Former Nursing Superintendent. She appreciated nurses for their role in not just caring for children but transforming their lives as well. There was overwhelmingly positive feedback from the participants, appreciating the speakers and the relevant topics. The conference served as a platform to elevate the standard of paediatric surgical nursing in India and to advance healthcare excellence, ultimately improving patient outcomes.



Medical Postgraduates Graduation Day 2025

On June 9th, the college community gathered to commemorate the Graduation Day for Medical Broad Speciality and Master's postgraduates, along with those who completed their PhDs in 2025. The event's chief guest was Surgeon Vice Admiral Arti Sarin, AVSM (Ati Vishisht Seva Medal) and VSM (Vishisht Seva Medal), Director General of the Armed Forces Medical Services.

The ceremony commenced with a grand procession featuring a traditional jasmine chain carried by finalyear medical students, led by the student General Secretary, Mr. Mounish M, followed by the graduating class and faculty members. The auditorium was filled with friends and family of the graduating classes, and the event was broadcast live online for those who could not attend in person to watch from afar. A total of 208 candidates received the broad speciality diploma/MD/MS, 15 earned a Master of Public Health, and 16 were awarded PhD degrees. The College Chapel service held the day before Graduation Day was a special Baccalaureate service conducted by the graduating postgraduates. Dr. Chandra Singh, Professor of Urology, delivered the message at the service.
