Observance of World Vitiligo Day 2025



The Department of Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy, in collaboration with the Dermatology Nursing Unit, organised a Patient Awareness Programme in commemoration of World Vitiligo Day on 25th June 2025 at the CMC Vellore Town Campus. The theme for this year's observance was 'Innovation for Every Skin,' highlighting the importance of inclusive and forward-thinking approaches in the dermatological care of vitiligo.

The nursing staff and faculty from the department organised a range of informative and interactive stalls, including displays on phototherapy units, live demonstrations of phototherapy techniques, a puppet show, and a counselling station. These exhibits aimed to educate patients and attendees about current treatment modalities while also offering psychosocial support. Additionally, a special stall called *Jus' Beads* by Karunai Illam showcased handmade jewellery and crafts created by marginalised and underprivileged communities from the Vellore and Tiruvannamalai regions.

In addition, various competitions were organised, such as the 'Healthy Food' Competition and the Poster and Slogan Writing competition. The healthy food competition was organised to promote the importance of nutrition and overall well-being, featuring an impressive array of both sweet and savoury dishes, attracting enthusiastic participation and fostering a spirit of camaraderie among attendees.

The programme was formally inaugurated in the presence of Dr. Myla Jacob, Deputy Medical Superintendent, Mrs. Daisy, Associate Nursing Superintendent, and Rev. Christina, Chaplain. The event was well-received and successfully met its objectives of raising awareness, promoting patient education, and celebrating advancements in the care and management of vitiligo.





World No Tobacco Day



To commemorate the 125th anniversary of CMC Vellore and World No Tobacco Day, the Tobacco Cessation Centre, Department of Pulmonary Medicine, organised a series of events. These included competitions for both staff and students, centred around the themes:

- Benefits of Quitting Smoking
- Ill Effects of Smoking
- Steps to Quit Smoking

Additionally, an awareness programme highlighting the harmful effects of tobacco and promoting healthy lifestyle choices was held at the Ranipet campus on 30th May, 2025.

The programme commenced with a prayer song led by the Pulmonary Medicine team, followed by a welcome address from Dr. Aswith, Assistant Professor. Dr. D. J. Christopher, Senior Professor, Pulmonary Medicine Department, gave an introductory note highlighting the significance of World No Tobacco Day.

The gathering was further honoured with felicitations from Dr. Ruben Thomas Kurien, Deputy Medical Superintendent, Mr Joseph Selvaraj, Deputy General Superintendent and Mrs. Reena George, Associate Nursing Superintendent. A powerful mime performance by the nursing team captivated the audience and conveyed the serious health risks associated with tobacco use and the benefits achieved after quitting. This was followed by a prize distribution ceremony recognising the winners of the short film and reel competitions, which were conducted to promote the anti-tobacco message among staff and students.

Obituaries

Dr. Prema Sachdeva (née Srinivasan) (MBBS batch of 1958-59) passed away on 29th June, 2025. Dr. Prema Sachdeva (née Srinivasan) passed away peacefully in Toronto, Ontario, at Sunnybrook Hospital after a brief illness. Dr. Prema was born in Pune, India, on October 20, 1938, the youngest of six children to Mr. R.S. Srinivasan, Deputy Assistant Controller at the Ministry of Defence, and his wife, Mrs. Swarupini. Due to her father's work, Dr. Prema's early years were spent in various parts of India before the family eventually settled in Ootacamund, Tamil Nadu, where she completed high school.



She went on to attend Vellore Medical College, graduating as a medical doctor in 1964. While in Vellore, she met Dr. Ramesh Sachdeva (MBBS batch of 1957), who would become her husband and life partner for 61 years. After their marriage in 1964, Dr. Prema joined Dr. Ramesh in Kenya. The couple later moved to the United Kingdom for further training, where Dr. Prema specialized in Obstetrics and Gynaecology.

They returned to Kenya in 1968, and Dr. Prema worked as an obstetrician in a government hospital. During this time, Dr. Prema and Dr. Ramesh welcomed their daughters, Mala Sachdeva, CPA, and Dr. Preeti Sachdeva. The family later moved to Lusaka, Zambia, where they lived and worked until 1974. That year, they immigrated to Winnipeg, Manitoba, which became home for the rest of Dr. Prema's professional career. She retrained in both General and Anatomical Pathology, worked as a pathologist at Victoria General Hospital, and later served as Director of Pathology at Concordia General Hospital until her retirement in 2005.

In addition to her professional accomplishments, Dr. Prema was a devoted wife, loving mother, and grandmother to her grandson, Jai Mehta. She was a gifted cook with a specialty in Indian cuisine, an avid gardener, and a passionate golfer during her years in Winnipeg.

In 2007, following retirement, Dr. Prema and Dr. Ramesh moved to Toronto to be closer to their grandson Jai. She cherished her later years, spending time with her family, learning about sports from Jai, staying engaged in politics and world affairs, and giving back through volunteer work and charitable contributions. Dr. Prema is survived by her husband, Dr. Ramesh; her daughters, Mala and Preeti (Rahul Mehta); her grandson, Jai; and her brother, Wg. Cdr. S. Sumukadas (IAF Retired) and many extended family members. Following the private funeral, which took place on July 4, 2025, prayers will be held on July 12, 2025, at 11:00 a.m. at the Arya Samaj Temple in Mississauga (405 Watline Avenue).
