State Level Workshop on 'Zero Harm in Surgery: Elevating Safety Standards in the Operating Room



The Department of Medical-Surgical Nursing speciality V, along with the Continuing Professional Advancement & Blended Learning Cell, College of Nursing, Christian Medical College Vellore, organised a state-level workshop on 'Zero Harm in Surgery: Elevating Safety Standards in the Operating Room', on 30th July, 2025. The workshop started with an inaugural programme in the CNE lecture hall, College of Nursing. A total of 53 delegates participated in the workshop from within the organisation and across the state.

In 1902, when Ida opened the Mary Taber Schell Hospital, she was the only qualified doctor, assisted by her mother, Sophia Scudder; her friend, Annie Hancock; and Salome, the cook's wife. Faculty from the Departments of Medical Surgical Nursing Specialty V, Anaesthesiology, Hospital Infection Control Committee (HICC), CMC Vellore, Scudder Memorial Hospital, Ranipet, and Mehta Hospital, Chennai, facilitated the sessions. The various topics focused during the workshop were: Safety aspects, Best Practices and Pitfalls, Infection Control Practices, Essential Protocol and Practices, Greening the Operating Rooms, ERAS: A way forward, and Legal and Ethical issues in OR. Skill sessions were conducted, focusing on Prevention of pressure injury, Circulator's Handoff Report, transferring patients safely, Surgical Counting Protocol, and Prevention of burns due to Diathermy. The delegates expressed a high level of satisfaction with the workshop. The Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council awarded 6 credit points for the workshop.

Clinical Epidemiology Unit organises Institutional Epidemiology Workshop

The Clinical Epidemiology Unit, CEU, organised the Institutional Epidemiology Workshop - protocol development for the first year MD/ MS / MOT post-graduates at the New Examination Hall between 04 and 06 August 2025 (Batch 1) on behalf of the principal's office. The workshop was attended by 89 MD/MS/MOT postgraduate registrars from all specialities. The workshop began with a word of prayer by Chaplain Rev. Joseph Devaraj, followed by a welcome address from Dr. Vignesh Kumar, Coordinator of CEU, and an inspiring talk on "Why do research?" by Dr. Sathya Subramani, Professor and Head of the Department of Physiology. The topics covered included research questions, study designs, research ethics, sample size calculation, data analysis, CRF creation, and practical sessions on literature search, data dictionary, Zotero software, Epidata software, PSPP software, and protocol development. The registrars had a group discussion session discussing their research topics and study designs with the faculty. The faculty consisted of Dr. JP Muliyil, Dr. Abraham Peedicayil, Dr. Thambu David, Dr. Sathish Kumar, Dr. Prasanna Samuel, Dr. S.S.Prakash, Dr. Azariah Jebakumar, Dr. Vignesh Kumar, Dr. Grace Rebekah, Dr. Reka, Mr. Rajagopal and Mr. Madhan Kumar. The workshop was well-received by the participants.



CME on Chest X-rays and Chest CT-Scans

The Department of Continuing Medical Education and the Department of Radiology organised a CME on *Chest X-rays and Chest CT Scans: An Introduction to Interpretations and Common Abnormalities* on 9th August, 2025. The programme was moderated by Dr. Aparna I., Professor, Department of Radiology. The speakers were Dr. Grace Rebecca, Dr. Shalini Sahu, and Dr. Manisha Mane, Department of Radiology; Dr. Chalasani Kiranmayi, Sprint Diagnostics, Hyderabad; Dr. Nikshita Jain, Consultant Paediatric Radiologist, Bai Jerbai Wadia Hospital for Children, Mumbai, and Dr. Sudha Kiran Das, Professor and Head, Department of Radiology, JSS Medical College, Mysuru. They discussed the systematic approach to interpreting adult and paediatric chest radiographs and cross-sectional imaging of the thorax.
