

#### **Obituaries**

**Dr. Sethu Bai (MBBS batch of 1942),** passed away on 15th August, 2025. Dr. Sethu Bai, from the first MBBS Batch (1942) passed away on 15 August 2025, a few months after her hundredth birthday.

Born on 5 January 1925 to K. Rangaswamy Mudaliar and Adilakshmi Ammal, Sethu Bai's childhood dream was to become a doctor. She did her intermediate studies in Vellore, where her father was then posted, one of the very few girls in the Voorhees College.



In 1942, when she joined the MBBS course at Vellore, Dr.Jessie Findlay was Acting Principal, Miss Treva Marshall was the warden of Women's Hostel and Dr. Edward Gault was Professor of Pathology.

The institution was still a women's college and had recognition only for pre-clinical studies. The hospital did not yet have men inpatients. Consequently, Dr. Sethu Bai and her classmates had their early clinical training in Madras during the heady years of the independence struggle. When CMC got provisional recognition for clinical training, the pioneering batch of girls returned to Vellore. They were among the last of the Vellore medical students to be taught by Dr. Ida Scudder herself, and the first to be taught by Dr. John Carman and Dr. Paul Brand. Dr. Sethu Bai remembered regular evening teas at Big Bungalow with Dr. Ida Scudder, Dr. Ida B Scudder and Treva Marshall, singing in the chapel, and lively games of tennis with her classmates. The commitment of her teachers, the camaraderie of hostel life, and the experience of compassion, faith, and service were memories she cherished for a lifetime.

CMC became co-educational, and in 1947, the senior girls welcomed the first ten men students. They saw their first Indian principal Dr. Hilda Lazarus hoist the national flag on India's first Independence Day, with Dr. Sethu Bai serving as the chairman of the Students Independence Day Committee. Dr. Ida Scudder, by then in her late seventies, was present at their graduation ceremony in 1948. After her graduation, Dr. Sethu Bai worked as house surgeon with Dr. Paul Brand and Dr. Reeve Betts in Vellore, and then went on to do her Diploma in Gynaecology and Obstetrics from Madras. On 5th May 1950, she married Dr. T. S. Bhaskaran, a doctor in the Indian Army and they worked in Erode. Their two daughters - Kalaichelvi and Mallika, both took up Medicine.

Dr. Sethu Bai's links to CMC continued through the next generations. Her daughter, Dr. Mallika Tiruvadanan, a palliative care physician and anesthetist has been examiner and teacher at CMC Vellore since 2008 and was present for the first Postgraduate Fellows in Palliative Medicine in the country. Her grandson, Dr. Senthil Sundaravadanan is one of the early alumni (2018 year) of CMC's Post-Doctoral Fellowship in Hepato-Pancreatico-Biliary Surgery.

Dr. Sethu Bai is survived by her daughters, Dr. Kalaichelvi, a retired anaesthesiologist and Dr. Mallika Tiruvadanan, a palliative care physician.
