CMC Vellore, Ranipet Campus, received an appreciation award for outstanding performance in the Deceased Donor Certification for the year 2024–25. The Transplant Authority of Tamil Nadu organised Organ Donation Day on September 23, 2025, during which the recognition was conferred. At this ceremony, CMC Vellore, Ranipet Campus, was honoured as one of the best hospitals in Tamil Nadu's Deceased Donor Programme for 2024–25. The award was presented by the Honourable Health Minister, Mr. Ma. Subramanian, and received by Dr. Nirmal T. J., Deputy Medical Superintendent. In addition, Mr. P. Jaisankar, Transplant Coordinator, M.S. Office, received an award from the Honourable Health Minister for being one of the best performers in the Deceased Donor Programme for the year 2024–25.

Workshop organised on Last Aid Training

A workshop on Last Aid Training was organised on 29th September 2025, by the Nursing Service, in collaboration with Last Aid International. The primary resource persons were Dr. Susan Speke, Last Aid Development Officer, Highland Hospice, UK, with her team and Dr. Leah Macaden, Senior Lecturer, The University of Edinburgh, Former Professor and Alumna, CMC Vellore. The objective of the workshop was to empower participants with basic knowledge, skills and confidence to support and care for people during times of serious illness, dying, death, and grief. The session was structured into four modules, covering topics such as understanding dying, death and grief, principles of palliative care, methods to relieve suffering, understanding the experiences of grieving individuals and the role of community support.

A total of 20 nurses from various departments attended the programme. Participants shared positive feedback, stating that they had gained a deeper and broader perspective on this "not so commonly discussed theme". They also expressed their eagerness to apply the practical insights gained to their clinical practice.
