CMC Vellore and Unifeeder Partner to Launch 'CERVICARE THRICE' Initiative for Women's Health



Empowering women through awareness, early detection, and accessible care.

CMC Vellore, 11 November 2025

Christian Medical College Vellore launched the **CERVICARE THRICE** initiative in partnership with Unifeeder, a DP World company. This community-based health initiative is designed to strengthen efforts across prevention, screening, early detection, and treatment of cervical cancer among women in India. Structured around the CERVICARE THRICE initiative, which strengthens cervical cancer prevention through screening and treatment, and the Geneva applicator, which enhances precision and accessibility in cervical cancer care, this initiative was inaugurated at CMC Vellore with the unveiling of the donor's plaque.



The CERVICARE THRICE initiative aims to reach more than 10,000 girls and women annually across Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Jharkhand, and Bihar through school and community-based awareness sessions. Around 3,000 women will also be screened annually using HPV as well as diagnostic tests, with identified precancerous cases receiving follow-up care and treatment using thermal ablation and LEEP (Loop Electrosurgical Excision Procedure) technologies.

The initiative will strengthen CMC Vellore's treatment capabilities through the introduction of advanced Geneva brachytherapy applicators, designed to deliver more precise and effective cancer therapy. These applicators are adaptable to a broad range of female pelvic anatomies—suitable for nearly 75% of cervical cancer patients—thereby improving treatment accuracy and efficiency while ensuring optimal tumour coverage with minimal radiation exposure to surrounding tissues.

Each patient undergoing treatment will be included in a structured follow-up and long-term support plan to ensure continuity of care and recovery. So far, over 1040 women in the community have been screened in with 146 identified as positives to be treated.





CME on Adult Vaccination

The Department of Infectious Diseases and the Department of Continuing Medical Education organised a CME on Adult Vaccination on 8th November 2025. The programme was moderated by Dr. Mohammed Shakeel, Assistant Professor, Department of Infectious Diseases. The speakers, Dr. Adrian Keith Noronha, Dr. Pooja Shah, and Dr. Mohammed Shakeel from the Dept. of Infectious Diseases, Dr. Divya Deodhar, Consultant, Dept. of Internal Medicine, Sultan Qaboos University, Muscat, and Dr. Satish Swain, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Infectious Diseases, Institute of Medical Sciences and SUM Hospital, Bhubaneswar provided a practical and up-to-date overview of adult vaccination, including vaccination in adults with comorbidities, in healthcare workers, and in pregnant women. The programme concluded with case discussions that could be translated into general practice. The programme was attended by more than 95 participants from 13 states and several departments in CMC. The CME Department thanks Dr. Priscilla Rupali, Professor and Head, Dept. of Infectious Diseases, Dr. Mohammed Shakeel, Telemedicine Department, and all the faculty for making the CME possible.

World Sight Day was celebrated at Schell Eye Hospital from October 6th to 25th 2025, under the themes **"Love Your Eyes at Work"** and **"Love Your Eyes – Kids".** The Outreach Services of Ophthalmology (Unit VI) conducted awareness and screening activities in rural, urban, and tribal areas, focusing on workplace eye safety and child eye health. Awareness, screening, and health education programmes were conducted for workers in coconut industries, solid waste management units, 100-day scheme sites, and among vegetable vendors. Eye screening camps for children were organised at Karunai Illam Child Home and within the Gypsy community, ensuring inclusive eye care for all.



The main event, held on October 11, 2025, at Schell Eye Hospital, began with a prayer and Bible reading. Rev. 
