CMC Vellore and The Hope House Renew Partnership to Boost Adolescent Health Education

The Adolescent Medicine Unit of the Department of Paediatrics, Christian Medical College Vellore, and local NGO The Hope House have renewed their Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to further strengthen and expand adolescent health education across the Vellore and Ranipet districts through Project YUVA (Young people Understanding and Verbalising Adolescence).



These include nutrition, sexual and reproductive health, self-harm, non-communicable diseases, violence, and mental health. Since its inception, Project YUVA has reached more than 6,000 adolescents across schools, colleges, and community settings, delivering over 700 structured health education sessions. Through this collaboration, health educators trained and mentored by Adolescent Medicine specialists at CMC deliver key adolescent health sessions in schools, colleges, and community settings, including government children's homes.

They visit five institutions each week, while teams from CMC and The Hope House meet every Saturday to review progress and refine implementation. The MoU signing was attended by Dr. Vikram Mathews, Director, CMC Vellore; Dr. Sneha Varkki, Professor and Head, Department of Paediatrics, CMC Vellore; Dr. Mona Basker, Professor and Adolescent Medicine Consultant and Member, State Commission for Protection of Child Rights, Tamil Nadu; Dr. Reshmi Y. S., Associate Professor, Department of Paediatrics; Mr. Ruby Nakka, Director, The Hope House; Mrs. Vinodhini Nakka, President, The Hope House; Dr. Grace Rebekah, Treasurer - The Hope House, and Mr. Daniel Mathew, Project Coordinator, Project YUVA. Project YUVA is also set to launch a mobile application and establish a dedicated call centre, expanding CMC's reach and making adolescent health information more accessible to young people across India.
