
Paul Brand Centre Marks 75 Years of Hand Research with Hand-Fracture Fixation Workshop

Smt. Indira Gandhi remains, to date, the only sitting Prime Minister to have visited the Christian Medical College Vellore.

During the workshop, trainee orthopaedic, hand, and plastic surgeons received expert guidance on the principles and techniques behind managing hand fractures. The day included specialist lectures, hands-on practice with saw bones, and an OSCE-style clinical scenario discussion.

Among the 116 attendees were trainee surgeons, consultants from orthopaedics, plastics and hand surgery, operating room nurses, hand therapists, and trainees.

Dr. Srinivasan Rajappa, Head of Hand Surgery at SRMC Chennai and a longstanding collaborator with CMC, served as visiting faculty.

The saw bone exercises were organised into modules where participants performed various fracture fixations ranging from basic to complex cases, under supervision from the hand surgery team. True to CMC's commitment to reducing waste and minimising carbon footprint, the event was conducted entirely without paper.



Workshop on Guideline Development



The Technical Resource Hub (TRH), CMC Vellore, under the Department of Health Research (DHR), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), organised a four-day workshop on “Guideline Development workshop” from the 6th to 9th January, 2026, at the New Examination Building, 2nd floor Conference Room, Bagayam Campus, CMC Vellore.

The inauguration ceremony commenced with a word of prayer by Rev. Vanisha, Chaplain. Dr. Mohan S Kamath, Principal Investigator of the Technical Resource Hub, Head and Senior Professor, Department of Reproductive Medicine & Surgery, and Director, Cochrane India Affiliate, CMC Vellore, welcomed the gathering, gave a brief introduction about the Technical Resource Hub and its scope of activities. He introduced the workshop and welcomed the participants. The session concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Mohan S. Kamath. The workshop was conducted over four days, covering key concepts and practical applications of systematic reviews, meta-analysis, and guideline development.

Day 1 focused on the foundations of systematic reviews, beginning with an introduction to randomised controlled trials as the building blocks of evidence synthesis. Sessions covered the core components of systematic reviews, protocol development, literature search strategies (including hands-on exercises), and screening and data extraction processes.

Day 2 emphasised quality assessment and evidence synthesis. Topics included an introduction to meta-analysis with hands-on practice, risk of bias assessment for randomised controlled trials, and an overview of diagnostic test accuracy (DTA) study designs, including risk of bias assessment for DTA studies.

Day 3 focused on the interpretation, reporting, and application of evidence. Sessions focused on DTA meta-analysis, assessing certainty of evidence using the GRADE approach, preparation of Summary of Findings tables, hands-on exercises, and an overview of the guideline development process and the role of Guideline Development Groups (GDGs).

Day 4 was dedicated to guideline development. The sessions covered the use of systematic reviews for guidelines and policy, GDG formation, topic prioritisation, framing of clinical questions (PICOS), prognosis-based reviews, and translating evidence into guideline recommendations using real-world examples.

Participants also engaged in practical exercises using RevMan software, GRADEpro and GDT to develop evidence profiles and Evidence-to-Decision frameworks, followed by discussions on stakeholder engagement, conflict of interest management, and effective communication of guideline recommendations. The features of the MetaDisc software were also discussed in detail.

The workshop faculty team included Dr. Prathap Tharyan, Dr. Mohan S. Kamath, Dr. Vignesh (Professor & Coordinator, Clinical Epidemiology Unit, CMC Vellore) and Dr. Jefferson Daniel (Assistant Professor, Department of Pulmonary Medicine, CMC Vellore). The sessions were highly interactive, encouraging active participation from attendees.

A total of 32 participants attended the workshop, including 14 participants from other institutions across India and one international participant. The participants expressed appreciation for the well-structured sessions and showed keen interest in attending future workshops organised by the department.

The department extends its gratitude to all resource persons, the Principal's Office for their support, and the Telemedicine and Online Teams for ensuring the smooth conduct of the workshop.



CME on Pharmaceutical Toxicology

The Poison Control Centre, Department of Medicine Unit-I and Department of Continuing Medical Education organised a CME on Pharmaceutical Toxicology on 10th January, 2026. The programme was moderated by Dr. Mohan Jambugulam and Dr. Amith Balachandran. The speakers, Dr. Mohan Jambugulam, Dr. Lino L.S., and Dr. Amith Balachandran from the Department of Medicine, and Dr. Sharada Sathish Kumar, Senior Consultant and Head, Paediatric Emergency Department, Dr. Mehta's Hospitals, Chennai discussed the drug handling by the human body in overdose, pharmaceutical toxicidromes, oral antidiabetic agents in overdose, antipsychotic agents in overdose, and clinical aspects of gastric decontamination strategies in pharmaceutical overdose.

The programme was attended by over 110 participants from 11 states and several departments in CMC. The CME Department thanks Dr. Krupa George, Professor and Head, Department of Medicine Unit-I, all the faculty, and the Telemedicine Department, for making the CME possible.
