**Prof. Santhi Lithiya Johnson**



The Christian Medical College Vellore, bids farewell to Prof. Santhi Lithiya Johnson, Professor and Acting Head, Department of Psychiatric Nursing, College of Nursing, on her retirement on 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2026 after nearly four decades of dedicated service in nursing, education, research, and patient care. A proud alumna of the College of Nursing, CMC Vellore, she completed her Diploma in Nursing in 1989, Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing in 2000, and M.Sc. Nursing (Psychiatric Nursing) in 2010. In 2016, she was granted Senior Training Fellowship in Geriatric Psychiatric Nursing at the University of Kansas Medical Centre, USA. Prof. Santhi began her career as a Staff Nurse in the Cardio-Thoracic and Paediatric Departments at CMC Vellore. She later served as a Senior Charge Nurse in the Ministry of Health, Oman, from 1993 to 1998. On returning to CMC, she worked in Emergency Services, served as a Project Nurse in the Department of Psychiatry, and spent three years on a major research project under Dr K. S. Jacob, contributing to pioneering studies on schizophrenia and mental health outcomes. Many patients whom she followed during research studies continue to seek her guidance.

Nursing, she joined the Psychiatric Nursing Department and is now retiring as Professor and Acting Head. A respected teacher and mentor, she was loved by students and staff alike for her approachable nature, encouragement, and genuine interest in their growth. Prof. Santhi has contributed extensively to psychiatric nursing through research publications, postgraduate mentorship, conference presentations, and service as a resource faculty member. She also held several institutional responsibilities, including serving as a Deputy Superintendent of University Exams, a member of the College of Nursing Research Committee, the Student Welfare Committee, and the Anti-Ragging Committee. She additionally contributed to international collaborative projects, including the CMC–Johns Hopkins University Wellness Initiative. ### Indo-Pacific Global Health Case Competition

## **Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University Online Certificate Course on Plasma Exchange (PLEX) to Treat Rodenticidal Hepatotoxicity – 2<sup>nd</sup> Contact Class**



The Contact Class for the 2<sup>nd</sup> (April 2026) Batch of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University Online Certificate Course on Plasma Exchange (PLEX) to Treat Rodenticidal Hepatotoxicity was conducted on 4 July 2026 at CMC Vellore. This course aims to improve the knowledge and practical skills of doctors caring for patients with suicidal ingestion of phosphorus containing rodenticide. Dr. B.J. Prashantham, Director, Dr Prashantham Institute for Counselling Psychology, Vellore, delivered a session on the prevention of deliberate self-harm.

The inaugural function was graced by Dr. Gomathi Karmegam (State TAEI Coordinator, representing Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project (TNHSP)), Dr. Jayaprakash Muliyl (Former Principal, CMC Vellore), Rev. Biswadip (Chaplain), Dr. Reuben Thomas (Deputy Medical Superintendent), Dr. Dolly Daniel (TMIH department), and Dr. C.E. Eapen (Course Coordinator). Lectures on evidence about efficacy of PLEX, standardized PLEX protocol, CMC Vellore experience with PLEX to treat liver failure were followed by panel discussion on real-life case scenarios (Dr Parthiban, Toxicology department, Government Vellore Medical College) and a hands-on demonstration of the PLEX procedure with a visit to High Monitoring Area in the ward. Faculty from Hepatology and TMIH departments (CMC Vellore) were the resource persons. The programme brought together participants from multiple healthcare institutions across Tamil Nadu, providing a valuable platform for academic exchange and capacity building in the management of acute liver failure.

## **Advanced Workshop on Design & Analyses of Randomised Controlled Trials in collaboration with McMaster University**

The Clinical Epidemiology Unit, in collaboration with McMaster University, Canada, organised a 5-day “Advanced Workshop On Design & Analyses Of Randomised Controlled Trials” between July 13 and 17, 2026 at the Stem Cell Research Centre auditorium, Rehab campus, Bagayam. The workshop began with an inauguration ceremony.



Dr. Vignesh Kumar, Professor, Clinical Epidemiology Unit and the course co-ordinator, delivered the welcome address. Rev. Joseph Devaraj, Chaplain, inaugurated the workshop with a word of prayer.



This was followed by the Chief Guest's address by Dr. Solomon Sathish Kumar, Principal, CMC Vellore. Dr. L. Jeyaseelan, Professor of Biostatistics, Mohammad Bin Rashid University, Dubai, Adjunct Professor, Clinical Epidemiology Unit, introduced the extramural faculty: Dr. Shrikant Bangdiwala, Director and Professor of Biostatistics, Population Health Research Institute, McMaster University, Canada and Mr. Kumar Balasubramanian, Statistical Operations Manager, Population Health Research Institute, McMaster University and Dr. Thambu David, Senior Professor, Clinical Epidemiology Unit. Dr. Shrikant Bangdiwala introduced the workshop to the participants.

The topics covered were; introduction to randomised controlled trials, research question, hypothesis, causal relationships, study designs, randomisation, sample size calculation including adjustments, statistical analysis plan, primary, secondary and sensitivity analyses, crude and subgroup analyses, regression analyses, interim analyses, group sequential methodology, conditional power, Bayes methodology, correlated data analyses – clustered and repeated measures data, Generalised Estimating Equations (GEE), Multilevel Modelling (MLM) & Cox regression model, interpretation of results, latest 'state of the art' in RCTs and a panel discussion with the faculty that also included Dr. Mohan S. Kamath, Director, Cochrane India Affiliate, CMC Vellore. The workshop consisted of lectures and group activity. Forty-eight participants from CMC and institutions from all over the country attended the workshop. The participants had a diverse background, including clinicians, statisticians, allied health and complementary medicine practitioners. The feedback was positive, with a suggestion to continue similar and advanced workshops in the future. The workshop was coordinated by the CEU faculty Mr. Madhan Kumar and Mr. Fredrick.

#### **(HeartCode® BLS – Blended Learning)**

The American Heart Association (AHA) Basic Life Support (BLS) – HeartCode® Provider Course will be conducted on the 25<sup>th</sup> August 2026 at Paul Brand Building, CMC Vellore.

**HeartCode® BLS** is the American Heart Association's blended learning pathway for BLS training. This modern format combines a Self-directed online learning session and mandatory hands-on skills training & assessment.
