9th Annual Renal Symposium and 18th Renal Clinical Conference: Advancing Acute Kidney Injury Education at CMC Vellore



National, International and CMC Faculty at the 9th Annual Renal Symposium and 18th RCC.

Conference Overview

The Department of Nephrology, Christian Medical College (CMC) Vellore, successfully conducted the 9th Annual Renal Symposium and 18th Renal Clinical Conference (RCC) on 24th– 25th July 2026 at the Ranipet Campus. The conference was organised under the leadership of Dr. Vinoi George David (Programme Convenor) and Dr. Nisha Jose (Organising Secretary). The meeting brought together over 150 delegates from across India, representing teaching hospitals, medical colleges and training institutions, for two days of intensive academic exchange and hands-on learning.

Pre-Conference Expert Interaction

Before the main conference, a two-day “Meet the Experts” programme was held for CMC faculty and postgraduate trainees. It included in-depth discussions on hepatorenal syndrome, critical care nephrology, fluid management, sepsis-associated Acute Kidney Injury (AKI), and point-of-care ultrasound (POCUS), promoting interaction between Nephrology and experts from Critical Care and Hepatology.

Scientific Programme and Keynote Faculty

The scientific programme featured renowned national and international faculty, including Dr. Kianoush Kashani (Mayo Clinic, USA), who delivered several keynote sessions on precision medicine, critical care nephrology and the evolving role of artificial intelligence in AKI.

Artificial Intelligence in Nephrology

Reflecting the rapidly evolving landscape of nephrology, the symposium devoted considerable attention to the role of artificial intelligence (AI) in clinical practice. Dedicated sessions explored the application of AI in nephrology education, clinical decision-making and critical care, highlighting how emerging technologies can support clinicians while emphasising the continued importance of sound clinical judgement. These discussions stimulated considerable interest among both trainees and practising nephrologists.

Hands-On POCUS and Ultrasound Workshop

A major attraction of the conference was the hands-on POCUS and ultrasound workshop, which offered participants practical training in focused cardiac ultrasound, renal artery Doppler imaging, lung ultrasound, inferior vena cava assessment, and renal biopsy techniques using contemporary equipment. Conducted in small-group stations under expert supervision and coordinated by Dr. Manish Lalwani and the workshop faculty, the programme provided participants with valuable opportunities to develop procedural skills that are increasingly integral to modern nephrology practice.

Case-Based Postgraduate Learning

The second day continued the long-standing RCC tradition of case-based postgraduate education. Participants engaged in clinical case presentations, mini-oral examinations, poster presentations and quiz competitions that closely simulated postgraduate and fellowship examinations. The interactive format encouraged analytical thinking, evidence-based discussions and peer learning, making the conference particularly valuable for residents and young nephrologists preparing for specialist training and examinations.

National Participation and Academic Exchange

The conference drew enthusiastic participation from delegates representing medical colleges and healthcare institutions from across the country, reaffirming RCC's growing reputation as a national educational platform in nephrology. The combination of internationally renowned faculty, innovative scientific sessions, practical workshops and trainee-focused learning created a vibrant academic environment that promoted both knowledge exchange and professional networking.

International Recognition in Theranostics-Department of Nuclear Medicine

10th Anniversary Celebration and Alumni Meet

The Department of Gynaecologic Oncology, Christian Medical College Vellore, successfully organised GYNOBOT 2026 – The Robotic Era, a National Video Workshop on Robotics in Gynaecology Oncology, on 1st August 2026 under the aegis of the Pondy TN AGOI Chapter.

The event marked a significant milestone as the department celebrated 10 years of excellence in Gynaecologic Oncology at CMC Vellore, commemorating a decade of M.Ch course teaching, dedicated patient care, academic excellence, research, and surgical innovation. The workshop was inaugurated with a prayer by Rev. Christinal, and felicitations by Dr. Solomon Sathishkumar, Principal, CMC Vellore and Dr. Binila Chacko, Deputy Director, CMC Vellore. The event was attended by more than 130 registered participants and more than 500 YouTube viewers who were faculties and delegates from neighbouring hospitals and Obstetrics and Gynaecology doctors in Tamil Nadu.

A major attraction was the SSI Mantra Robotic Experience Bus, where delegates had the opportunity to interact with the SSI Mantra robotic platform through guided demonstrations and hands-on simulator sessions. This immersive experience enabled participants to gain practical exposure to robotic technology and was especially appreciated by consultants, fellows, and postgraduate trainees.

The academic programme also included GYNOBOT Quiz 2026, in which each team comprised one M.Ch. trainee and one postgraduate trainee, promoting collaborative learning. The first prize was awarded to Dr. Lekshmi S.A. and Dr. Prithikaa, while the runners-up were Dr. Mary Sophy and Dr. Anurag.

10th Annual Thoracic Ultrasound Workshop and Course



The Department of Respiratory Medicine, Christian Medical College Vellore, successfully conducted the 10th Annual Thoracic Ultrasound Workshop and Course on 31st July and 1st August 2026 at the Town Campus. The workshop marked a significant milestone in the department's ongoing commitment to excellence in medical education and procedural training.

Over the past decade, the workshop series has trained numerous postgraduate students and early-career physicians from across the country. The programme combines interactive lectures with extensive hands-on training, providing participants with an opportunity to develop practical skills in thoracic ultrasound and ultrasound-guided procedures.

The workshop featured live supervised ultrasound scanning on healthy volunteers and hands-on sessions using wet goat models. These simulation-based activities enabled participants to gain practical experience in a safe and structured learning environment. The workshop was inaugurated by Dr. Deepak Selvaraj, Associate Director, CMC Vellore; Dr. Myla Yacob, Deputy Medical Superintendent, Medical Superintendent's Office; and Ms. Priscilla, Chaplaincy Department.

The academic programme was supported by a multidisciplinary faculty comprising experts in Respiratory Medicine, Medical ICU, Emergency Medicine and Anaesthesia, as well as invited external faculty. The diverse faculty highlighted the expanding role of thoracic ultrasound across respiratory medicine, critical care, anaesthesia, emergency medicine, and pleural procedures. The workshop received enthusiastic participation from delegates across the country, including trainees from Respiratory Medicine, Anaesthesia, and Emergency Medicine. The interactive sessions provided an excellent platform for learning, skill development, and academic exchange.

The successful completion of the 10th Thoracic Ultrasound Workshop represents a decade of sustained efforts towards capacity building and the advancement of procedural skills in respiratory medicine. As CMC Vellore commemorates 125 years of service and 100 years of excellence in education, the Department of Respiratory Medicine remains committed to its mission of excellence in education, clinical service, and research, while continuing to nurture the next generation of respiratory and critical care physicians.





21st Annual Post Graduate CME in Haematology

The 21st Annual Post Graduate CME in Haematology was held from 29th – 31st July 2026, jointly organised by the Departments of Haematology and Immunohaematology & Blood Transfusion. The programme aimed to provide postgraduate students in Medicine, Pathology, and Paediatrics with a comprehensive overview of Haematology. The CME received an excellent response, with 285 participants (160 external participants from 67 colleges and 125 postgraduate students from CMC Vellore). Spanning two and a half days, the programme offered didactic lectures, interactive clinical case discussions, and laboratory tours, providing participants with valuable exposure to both the clinical and laboratory aspects of Haematology. Faculty members also interacted with students on training opportunities and career prospects in the specialty.

The scientific programme featured 24 internal faculty members and 4 external experts, who delivered lectures, demonstrations, and interactive sessions. The integration of clinical teaching with laboratory exposure was particularly well appreciated by the participants and contributed significantly to the success of the CME. The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University accredited the program with 25 credit points and The Tamil Nadu Medical Council accredited the program with 6 credit hours.

Paediatric Clinical Immunology and Rheumatology Division, Department of Paediatrics, CMC Vellore, successfully hosted the 24th National Conference of the Pediatric Rheumatology Society of India (NCPR 2026), bringing together leading paediatricians, researchers, and rheumatology professionals from across the country and the globe. The highly anticipated medical summit took place at the Scudder Auditorium in Bagayam, featuring a pre-conference workshop and CME on July 30, followed by the main conference on July 31 and August 1, 2026.

Centred around the theme, **‘Translating Excellence in Paediatric Rheumatology: Global Guidelines in Resource-Conscious Care,’** the three-day event aimed to bridge the gap between world-class medical advancements and accessible healthcare delivery in developing regions. NCPR 2026 was accredited by The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University with 30 credit points and the Tamil Nadu Medical Council with 6 credit hours. 270 participants attended the conference. The inaugural programme was graced by Rev. Paul Ravikumar, Dr. Leena, Deputy Director, Dr. Rajesh I, Medical Superintendent, Dr. Suita Danda, Patron, NCPR 2026, and Dr. Deepti Suri, President of the Paediatric Rheumatology Society of India.

Key Highlights and Scientific Advancements

The comprehensive scientific programme offered a deep dive into the latest clinical breakthroughs for treating children with complex rheumatic and musculoskeletal diseases. Key focus areas of the clinical sessions included:

- *Juvenile Idiopathic Arthritis (JIA)*: Experts discussed clinical spectrums, challenges, and the integration of newer therapies, such as the intersection of biologic revolutions and small molecule precision treatments.
- *Critical Syndromes & Diseases*: Dedicated panels unmasked the complexities of Kawasaki Disease, Systemic Lupus Erythematosus (SLE), Juvenile Dermatomyositis (JDM), and severe autoinflammatory syndromes.

- *The Dr. Balu Athreya Oration:* A major highlight of the main conference schedule, celebrating legacy and continuous innovation in paediatric care. The oration was given by Dr. Suma Balan, from Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences, Kochi.
- *Cross-Specialty Collaboration:* Multi-specialist discussions on paediatric uveitis, childhood interstitial lung disease (ILD), and managing medical emergencies in paediatric rheumatology showcased a multidisciplinary approach to patient care.

Organised under the leadership of Organising Chairman Dr. T. Sathish Kumar and Organising Secretaries Dr. Sathish Kumar Loganathan and Dr. Murugan S, the conference served as a vital platform for dynamic case-based discussions, clinicopathological conundrums, and hands-on learning.

In NCPR 2026, 90 e-posters and 30 Challenging Case posters were presented by various young MD residents and DM students from all over the country. By fostering meaningful dialogues, presenting groundbreaking research, and sparking fresh ideas, NCPR 2026 has set a new benchmark for collegial partnerships, ensuring that the next chapter in paediatric rheumatology will continue to improve the quality of life for young children.

This 2-day course is designed for healthcare providers (doctors, nurses, and paramedics) who initiate advanced life care in acutely ill adults, beyond basic life support, through the stabilisation or transport phases of adult emergency care. This Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support Course is accredited by the American Heart Association and is valid internationally. The number of participants is strictly restricted to 24, as per AHA guidelines. The ACLS lead faculty were Dr. Ekta Rai from the Department of Anaesthesia; Dr. Leah Maria Raju, Dr. Bernice Theodore, and Dr. Andrew Solomon from the Department of Anaesthesia; and Dr. Priya G. and Dr. Anjali R. from Emergency Medicine. 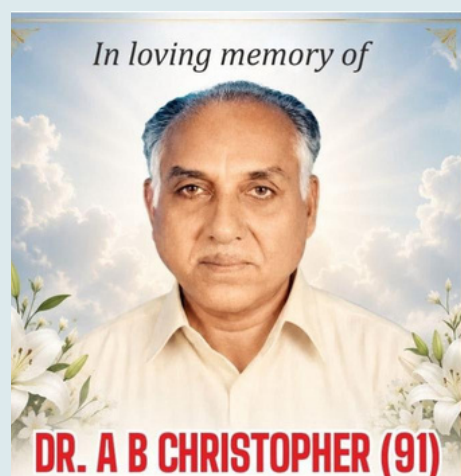
